- ▶ Providing public safety and justice
- ▶ Holding elections at every level of government
- ▶ Maintaining Texans' most important records
- ▶ Building and maintaining roads, bridges and in some cases, county airports
- ▶ Providing emergency management services
- ▶ Providing health and safety services
- ▶ Collecting property taxes for the county and sometimes for other taxing entities
- ▶ Issuing vehicle registration and transfers
- ▶ Registering voters.
